



Le français, c'est trop bien!

Eligibility:

The FTA Poster Competition **Le français, c'est trop bien!** is being run in conjunction with the 2019 FTA National Conference in Carrick-on-Shannon 11-12th October 2019. It is open to all first and second year students whose contact teacher has registered for the 2019 conference. The poster must be the unaided, individual work of the student and must not have been submitted for any other competition. Individual entries only. One entry per student.

The poster:

The poster will be **no larger than A3** in size. It should feature the caption '**Le français, c'est trop bien!**' Any other words on the poster must also be in French. Any drawing or painting materials can be used.

Content:

No bad language, no sexual references, no violence and no copyrighted material can feature on the poster.

Submission form:

A duly completed submission form (i.e. the next page) must be stapled to the back of each poster entry The contact teacher must confirm that s/he has registered to attend the FTA conference. Schools may make multiple submissions but each entry must be accompanied by a separate submission form. Permission must be given by the student's parent/guardian and by the school principal for the winning entries to feature on **fta.ie**.

Deadline:

Each poster entry must be physically attached to a duly completed submission form (next page) and sent to:

Assessment criteria

Judging panel: The judging panel for the **2019 Le français, c'est trop bien! Poster Competition** will include an art teacher and a French language specialist. As many of the teachers submitting their students' work are members of the FTA, no member of the FTA will be on the judging panel.

Criteria:

The winning posters will illustrate in a visually appealing way the idea of **Le français, c'est trop bien!** The poster will encourage students to learn, speak and enjoy French.

Awards/ Prize-giving

A selection of the posters received will be displayed during the **2019 FTA National Conference**. The winning entries will be announced on Saturday morning October 12th 2019 when the teachers of the winning entries will be presented with their plaques and prizes.

'Meilleur poster': Winning plaque and €50 voucher for International Books, Dublin 2.

Poster: 'prix de créativité': Winning plaque and €40 voucher for International Books, Dublin 2.

The 2 winning posters will feature on **fta.ie** with the school's name as well as the names of the winning students and contact teachers if permission is received.

Return of posters:

All posters will be left at the back of the conference hall for collection after the conference. The FTA will not be responsible for posters once the conference has ended and will not return by mail any posters which have not been collected.
